ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 6.102-9/08*

IN RE: MATTERS TO BE FILED IN
PROBATE AND GUARDIANSHIP DIVISION

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The following matters, except those specified below, shall be filed with and conducted by the Probate and Guardianship Division of the Court. All proceedings pertaining to:
 - a. Florida Probate Code (Ch. 731-35 F.S.);
 - b. Florida Guardianship Law (Ch. 744 F.S.);
 - c. Conservators and Curators (Ch. 747 F.S.);
 - d. Trusts (complaints filed under Ch. 736 F.S. or Ch. 86 F.S. relating to the administration of, or rights of beneficiaries in trusts);
 - e. Baker Act (Ch. 394 F.S.);
 - f. Hal S. Marchman Alcohol and Other Drug Services Act (Ch. 397 F.S.);
 - g. Adult Protective Services Act (Sec. 415.105 F.S.);
 - h. Compulsory Treatment and Commitment of Persons Afflicted with Tuberculosis (Sec. 392.55, 392.56, 392.57 F.S.); and
 - i. All proceedings for determination of incapacity pursuant to Ch. 744 F.S.
2. All actions properly filed with the Probate and Guardianship Division which contain a cognizable right to trial by jury may be transferred to the appropriate Civil Division at the option of the Probate and Guardianship Division presiding judge.
3. Action seeking relief in the nature of constructive and resulting trusts shall be filed in the Civil Division. All independent civil actions filed against an estate or trust as a result of an objection to a claim filed against a decedent's estate pursuant to F.S. Section 733.702, et al., or against a trust pursuant to F.S. Section 736.1008 shall be filed in the Civil Division
